Mostly, we do not change these kinds of sentences to Superlative degree.

P.P. Very few singers sing as skillfully as Lata.

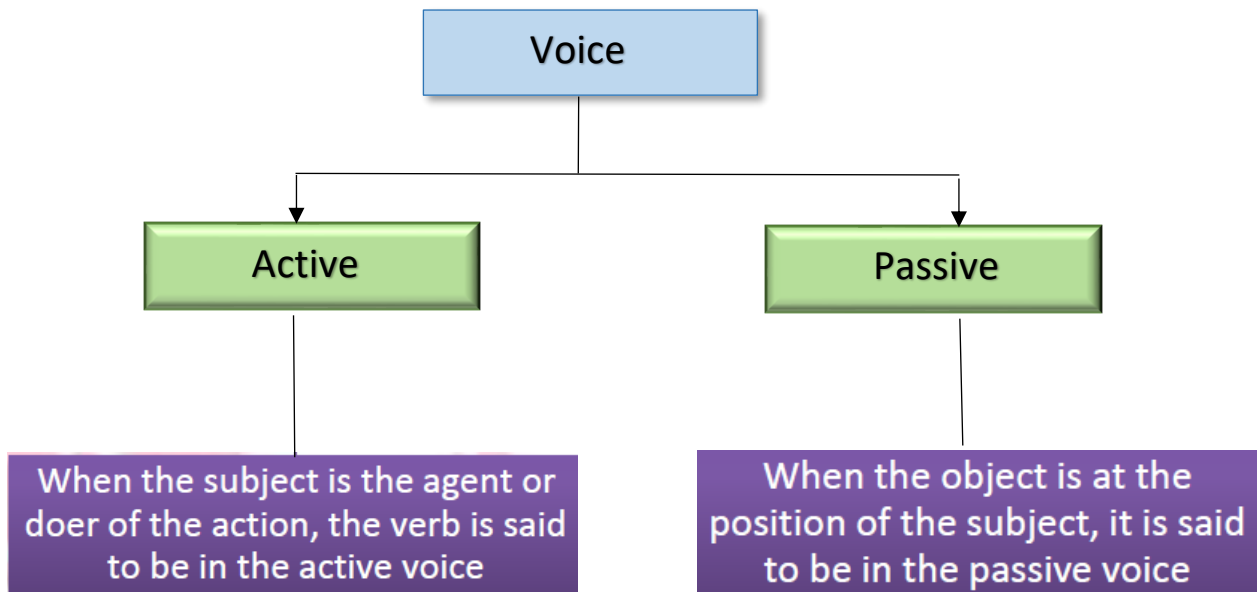
